# EFG1914: What is it about?

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## Key figures

- EU Programme: ICT-PSP, Pilot type B
- Reference number: 297266
- Start: 15 February 2012
- Duration: 24 months
- 25 partners including 20 film archives & cinémathèques
- Follow-up project of EFG – The European Film Gateway

## Objectives

- ▶ Digitisation of 654 hours of film
- ▶ Digitisation of ca. 5.600 film-related objects
- ▶ Making the digitised content available online through the [European Film Gateway](#) and [Europeana](#)
- ▶ Adapting the EFG aggregation system and portal to the needs of EFG1914
- ▶ Build a virtual exhibition around themes of WWI, based on the EFG infrastructure




